Congressman heads for China

Congressman William S. Broomfield (R-19) has been picked by President Gerald Ford to be part of a seven-member goodwill mission to the People's Republic of China. The envoys, the sixth group of U. S. officials to visit mainland China since former President Richard Nixon's historic journey, depart Saturday and return Sept. 14 after touring China and meeting government officials there.

BROOMFIELD will join Sena-tors J. William Fullbright (D-Ark.), Hubert Humphrey (D-Minn.), Hiram Fong (R-Hawaii); and fellow representatives Bar-bara Jordan (D-Tex.), Peter Frelin-

Customers will hear a familiar voice in the recordings, that of Jane Barby of Atlanta, Ga. She is the "time lady" whose voice is now heard on the recorded time-of-day announcements. And, in fact, the new intercept recordings follow much the same pattern as the time recordings.

much the same pattern as the time recordings. For the time-of-day announce-ments, various hours, minutes and seconds are separately recorded as well as appropriate phrases. These are then pulled together from a magnetic drum to give the cus-tomer the correct time when he or she calls the time number. In the new intercent events that

In the new intercept system, the recorded messages include such phrases as "The number you have reached," and a operator will an-swer," and "the new number is," Additionally, recordings have been made by Mrs. Barby of various numbers and words. All together, there are 96 tracks on a magnetic drum which are pre-recorded with phrases, words and
