Jolie Gabor leads lineup

The 1974-75 Farmington Town Hall lecture and luncheon series gets under way on Thursday, Oct. 3 in Northland Theater with Jolie Gabor leading the four-part series.

Allen Funt, Shirley Eder and Leo Narducci fill out the celebrity roster sponsored by the Farmington Soroptimist Club. Each of the lectures begin at 11 a.m. and each is followed by a celebrity luncheon in the new

Michigan Inn in Southfield, located next to the theater.

The luncheon is optional for season ticket holders only, and no individual luncheon reservations will be taken.

JOLIE GABOR, "mama" to Magda, Eva and Zsazsa, brings her lecture, "It's Never Too Late" which continues "to enjoy life or to embark on new adventures."

Trapped in Hungary during most of World War II and divorced after 22 years of marriage, Ms. Gabor escaped Europe on an old Portuguese cargo ship to begin a new life as a career woman.

She now owns Madison Avenue and Palm Prings jewelry shops and made some "bold" real estate investments that made her an extremely wealthy woman.

"All the Gabors are, first and foremost, women," she says, "and we have the same problems, frustrations, fears and desires that are universal

with members of the feminine gender."

In her lecture she will discuss her philosophy of life and tell her au-

dience some of the Gabor beauty secrets.

ALLEN FUNT comes to the Farmington Town Hall on Nov. 14. The producer of "Candid Microphone" and "Candid Camera" will lecture on "Behind the Candid Camera" confessing to a lifetime of eavesdropping and catching people off-guard in the act of being themselves. He will also show the funniest of the Candid Camera scenes that could not be televised.

"Psychologists are only now starting to realize the value of allowing people to study themselves and their behavior in off-guard moments to correct everything from annoying little habits to major behavioral patterns," Funt says.

Having conducted experiments in many phases of human behavior for and with the assistance of Professor James Maas of the Cornell University Psychology Department, he is now prepared to illustrate the use of the Candid Camera as a psychological tool.

SHIRLEY EDER appears in the series on Feb. 20 with her talk, "A Star's Rendezvous With the Stars."

The nationally syndicated Hollywood columnist will discuss show biz and the famous people who make it glamorous.

"I've always got stars in my eyes, and my eyes on the stars," Ms. Eder says, who for most of her adult life has moved in show business society circles. She has met and interviewed most of the leading stars and is a repeat guest on many TV talk shows.

LEO NARDUCCI, one of America's top 10 fashion designers will appear on March 20. His clothes are designed for the women who are 30ish, fashionable Middle America.

In his talks, instead of burbling phrases like "absolutely divine" and "tres chic," he says things like "in-expensive" and "washable."

Of Ms. America, he says, "She's a mover, very often a career girl, city-fied or a suburbanite. Her head isn't just wrapped up in clothes. She's a doer, and therefore, what she puts on her back must do for her also. These are down-to-earth clothes with prices to match."

The awards and honors which have been bestowed on Narducci are numerous.
