5 achieve Eagle rank

After 10 years without a single Eagle Scout, Boy Scout Troop 135 of Southfield now has five.

U. D. plans centennial

The University of Detroit will begin a year-long celebration of its centennial in two years, on Sept. 4, 1976.

The year-long centennial program will culminate Sept. 4, 1977, the day marking the 100th anniversary of the founding of U. of D. The Jesuit university's original location was on East Jefferson Ave. near what is now the Chrysler Expressway.

According to U. of D.'s Centennial Coordinator, Carol Roulier, "The university hopes to focus the nation's attention on the university and its heritage in the city of Detroit. Those of us at U. of D. who are involved in the Centennial plan to focus on U. of D.'s rich philosophical and religious tradition."

"The Centennial Planning Committee and other advisory committees are now being organized. Membership is open to all members of the university community, interested Detroit citizens and friends of the university."

Details regarding centennial year activities will be forthcoming following the selection of committee members.

O.U. offers new courses

Several new courses in the diploma programs for medical office and ophthalmologic/optometric assistants are offered evenings by Oakland University's Division of Continuing Education in the fall term, which begins the week of Sept. 30.

New noncredit courses are hospital organization and patient services, medical law and ethics, medical correspondence skills and pre-clinic practice in eye doctors' offices.

Other courses offered include medical terminology I and II, human anatomy and physiology, insurance forms, office organization and management, and psychology and behavior courses.

Specifically for those concerned with eye care, courses cover anatomy and physiology of the eye, instrument and patient procedures, and laboratory and dispensing duties.

Any course may be taken without enrolling in one of the diploma programs. To request detailed brochures and to register, call 377-3120.
