The 50-year-old McCabe, until recently chef at the Country Club of Jackson, is not kidding. He ran as a write-in candidate in

New Hampshire in 1960, then became active again briefly in 1964. He's a Democrat now, although the earlier forays were as a Republican. McCabe says he believes a public servant should "have the guts to enforce the law or the guts to demand that the law be abolished."


