Hawks fly 28-6

Farmington Harrison senior quarterback Sam Rink scored three touchdowns as he led the Hawks to their second consecutive victory of the season, a 28-6 pasting of Birmingham Groves.

Rink got started early, going three yards off left tackle midway through the first quarter as the Hawks drew first blood, the drive had originated on the Groves 38-yard line.

Following a change of possessions, Groves was forced to punt in its own territory. But the snap from center sailed over the punter's head and Harrison took over on the Groves' 13-yard line.

Four plays later, Rink scored his second touchdown on a one-yard plunge. The conversion made the score 14-0 Harrison.

The third quarter saw Harrison threaten twice, moving both times to within the Groves' 35-yard line. But both times Groves came up with the big play to stay in the game.

Midway through the quarter, with Harrison threatening, junior Falcon Tom Williams picked off a Rink pass and returned the ball to the Groves' 41-yard line to keep the pressure off.

game away in the fourth quarter and Groves' errors were to help them do it.

With 6:49 remaining, the Hawks set up for a 34-yard field goal attempt. The kick was short, but an over-enthusiastic Groves' player had landed on the Harrison kicker in his attempt to block the kick. The subsequent penalty brought the ball to the Groves' 12-yard line with Harrison maintaining possession.

Two plays later, Rink made it three touchdowns for the night and the conversion made the score 21-0.

Following the ensuing kickoff, Groves made its final mistake of the evening and this one needed no help from Rink to convert.

On first and 10 from the Groves' 27, Hawk Bob Miller stepped in front of a Groves receiver in the flat and took the ball all the way in from 30-yards out for the icing on the cake.

Groves made its scoring drive with time running out on a series of long plays culminating in a nine-yard scoring pass to senior halfback Jim Rygiel with 1:40 remaining.

AFTER THE conversion had failed, Harrison ran the clock out to claim the victory.

The Hawks now boast a 2-0 record and will play Northville next week in the league opener for both clubs.

Groves saw its record evened up at one and one and will host Utica Eisenhower this Friday night.

GROVES TOOK the ball nine yards in three plays and with fourth and one, Groves coach Rink decided to gamble and came up short.

Harrison moved the ball quickly to the Groves' 35-yard line where senior Falcon tackle Mark Volger fell on a loose ball to give Groves possession again.




