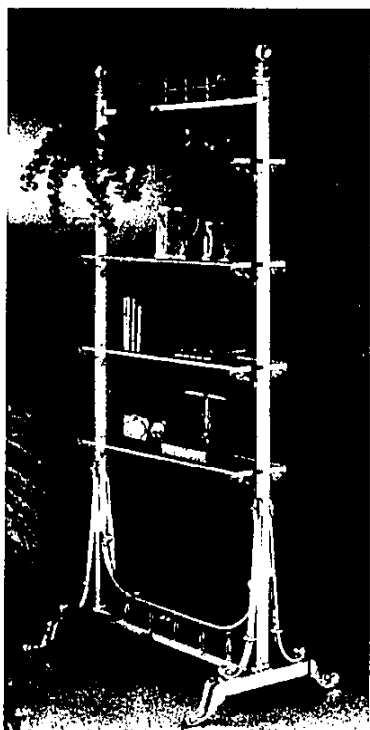


Showcase a collection

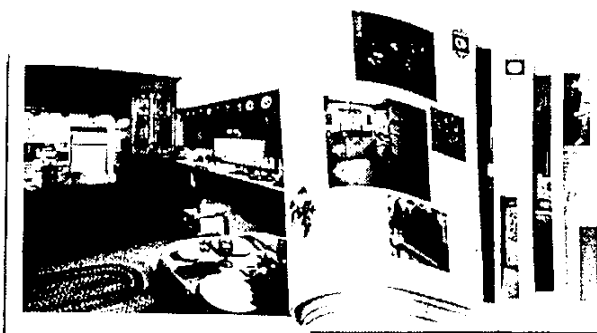

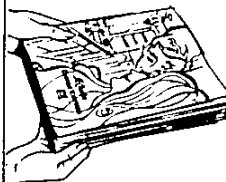
