Time is running out for youngsters hoping to win Punt. Pass and Kick (PP&K) honors but who have not yet registered for 1974 competition.

Registration at Ford dealerships closes Oct. 4. The first of six levels of competition will be held Oct. 5, at foot-ball fields, parks and playgrounds around the nation.

The six levels of competition are local, zone, district, area, divisional and final. Twelve finalists, two in each of the six age groups will compete at the nationally televised National Football Conference championship. Dec. 29. All finalists and their parents will be guests at the game.
