## Clarenceville victim, 15-14

# Lakers win in overtime

West Bloomfield's Lakers made the most of an overtime period Friday night and walked away with a thrilling 15-14 victory over Clarenceville.

At the end of regulation time the teams had battled to an 8-8 tie. The Lakers won the coin toss and elected to take the ball first in the overtime session.

On the initial series of downs, Laker End John Jorgensen grabbed an eight yard pass on the third play from Quarterback Rob Hinsberg to break the deadlock.

Dave Ninowski kicked the extra point to put WB ahead 15-8.

Clarenceville bounced back with a touchdown on the ensuing series of downs to come within one, but an attempted pass for the extra point fell short giving the Lakers their third consecutive victory of the '74 season. The locals dropped behind 8-0 early in the second quarter as Clarenceville relied on a hefty running attack to score.

Late in the second quarter the Lakers took the ball over at the mid-field stripes. Hinsberg highlighted the drive with a nine yard pass to Halfback Vince Vuichard which put the

ball on the five yard line.

Hinsberg then carried the ball four yards followed by a one yard effort by Bob Wilson with 33 seconds left.

Wilson ran the conversion to deadlock the score 8-8.

Penalties marred West Bloomfield's chances in the third quarter as two 15-yard infractions stalled the Lakers' offense.

Ninowski attempted a desperation field goal outside the 35 with 22 seconds remaining, but the chance fell short, setting the stage for the overtime finally.

Wilson led all Laker rushers with 40 yards gained.

## Ford PPK deadline near

Time is running out for youngsters hoping to win Punt, Pass and Kick (PPK) honors but who have not yet registered for 1974 competition.

Registration at Ford dealerships closes Oct. 4. The first six levels of competition will be held Oct. 5, at football fields, parks and playgrounds around the nation.

This is the 14th season for PPK, the largest youth program of its kind in the United States. This year more than 1,200,000 boys and girls are expected to enter the contest that will put six of their names in the Football Hall of Fame.

Cosponsored by the National Football League (NFL) and Ford dealers throughout the country, PPK is open to boys and girls from 8 to 13. Eligible youngsters can register at any Ford

dealership when accompanied by a parent or guardian. Registrants compete only against those in their own age group. No special equipment is needed.

The competition, based on distance and accuracy, awards one point for every foot of punting, passing and kicking distance and deducts one point for each foot away from a center line.

The six levels of competition are local, zone, district, area, divisional and final. Twelve finalists, two in each of the six age groups will compete at the nationally televised National Football Conference championship, Dec. 29. All finalists and their parents will be guests at the game.

National winners will have their

names inscribed on the permanent PPK displayed at the Pro Football Hall of Fame in Canton, Ohio. NFL commissioner Pete Rozelle will present the winner's trophies.

## 'Hawks have triple win

The Southfield Jayhawks had the Redford Raiders seeing triple in the Little Football League games last Sunday. Southfield won the varsity contest, 18-0; the junior varsity game, 32-0; and the pony game, 13-6.

In varsity action, Tom Longroy and Mike Hopkins each scored a touchdown on runs of 25 yards. Tim Moore ran 12 yards for the other score. Southfield's defense, led by Mitch McCann and Ken Sullivan, allowed Redford just two first downs.

Ken Mignone scored three touchdowns on runs of 15, 55 and 40 yards to lead the junior varsity route. Ronnie Dorland and Hugh Watts also added running touchdowns. Redford failed to make a first down against the Jayhawk defense, which was led by Glen Martin and Glen Pulice.

The Jayhawks' pony squad was trailing 6-0, but Gary Levenson took the second half kickoff and raced 60 yards for a touchdown which tied the score. John Vincenti ran for the extra point, and the Jayhawks were ahead to stay. Southfield's Ricky Yerex added an insurance touchdown in the last quarter.

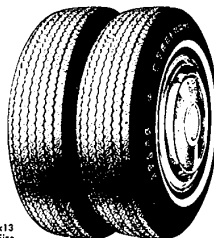

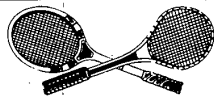
