It seems that many viewers feel personal hygiene should not be paraded on the airwaves - at least not in prime time. Therefore, stations try to schedule those ads for late-night programming.

ONE GENTLEMAN was satisfied on a breach of promise complaint when WJBK leaped to his assistance. He had called to protest that, despite Burger King's assurances that you can have it your way, he couldn't. For medical reasons the man could not eat seeds, but he couldn't get a bun without sesame seeds from Burger

He complained to WJBK who, in turn, contacted the hamburger chain's district manager. The problem was brought up at the company's board meeting in Miami and now the chain is planing to offer seedless buns too. 
