"Dirty or clogged filters will not low the furnace to operate effi-ently and this wastes fuel. If a aimney is clogged with an obstacle

such as a bird's nest, the exhaust furnes will not properly vent to the outside air. This is a potentially fatal problem that can be alleviated by a thorough inspection."

THOMAS SAID that Consumers Power studies show that up to one-third of the fuel used for heating a home can be wasted if the dwelling is improperly insulated and overly drafty.

He suggested the following tips to help ensure that the home and not the outside air is heated:

Properly insulate the dwelling. The general recommended level is six

inches of quality insulation in the ceiling to keep the heat inside where it is

ing to Reep the near hands when the needed.

Install storm windows. Their cost can be recovered in a few years through energy savings you will realize. The storm windows keep heat from escaping through drafty windows.


