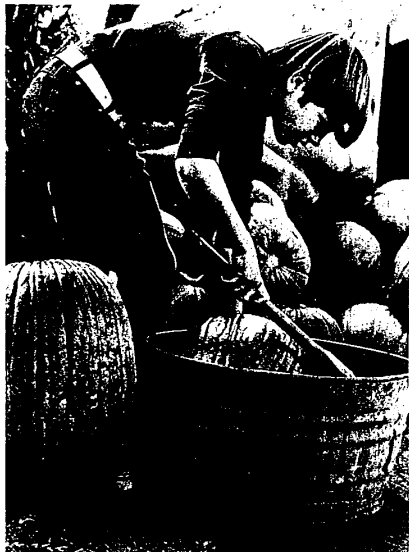


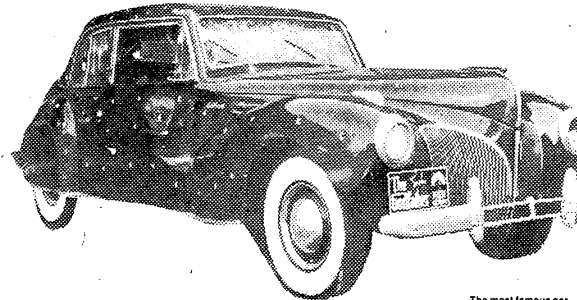


Harvest colors Farmington landscape

The car which played a key role belonged to the Godfather's flamboyant son, Sonny Wortzik. When Sonny was ambushed at a tollbooth, it triggered an all-out war between rival "families" and brought the film to its crescendo of action. Paramount Pictures decided that a 1941 Lincoln Continental would be perfect for Sonny because it has all the characteristics of a gangster car. It was powerful for its time—a V-12 engine with 292 cubic inches and 120 horsepower. It was one of the more expensive and rare cars of its day. The 1941 Lincoln Continental is a true classic and is certain to maintain its historical position throughout the future of motorcar design.
