The event was the Dance of the Decades, brought to you by the same folks who will bring you the Bicenternial Festival of Detroit Dance Companies on May 30:1, 1975.

The dance was a fund raiser to assure the actuality of such a festival in 75 and included 13 of the more than 30 dances companies that thrive in Detroit.
