## Drug group adds new staff members

Volunteers comprise the bulk of the workers involved with the three programs.

The medical clinic alone uses the services of six physicians, eight nurses, four lab technicians, two social workers and 15 intake workers.

For hotline, the number of volunteers varies from 10 to 30 persons.

**SPECIAL** training is required for this program.

Volunteers go through a pre-screening before a 40-hour training session. Another screening follows as well as supervision once the volunteers man the phone.

There is always back-up supervisory personnel available.

Hotline uses the peer counseling concept. Youths handle calls from youths and adults handle calls from adults.

All three programs are concerned with education.

They will present programs to parent groups, community service groups as well as distribute flyers.

The council circulated flyers detailing the drug PCP following the recent overdoses in Milford.

The non-profit organization has been in existence for almost five years.

**RAPLINE** was started in February, 1970. The advisory council was formed shortly after that in July. The medical clinic didn't come along until last April.

The advisory council depends on donations from the cities of Farmington and Farmington Hills as well as the county to keep both the substance abuse program and hotline going. A grant from the federal government provides funds for the clinic.

**IN DECEMBER**, the council will undertake its annual fund-raising drive.

The primary ages for substance abuse is ninth and 10th grades, which coincides with puberty and the process of becoming an adolescent, Young said.

## Council takes applications for appointment

**FARMINGTON HILLS**—Margaret Schaeffer, recently elected to the newly created 47th district court judgeship, resigned her position on the city council Monday night.

Mrs. Schaeffer tendered her resignation in a letter to the council. The city's charter requires that the council choose a new member to serve until the next council election.

To find a qualified person to fill the vacancy, the council is asking persons who would like to serve to submit a resume. A Dec. 15 deadline was set.

Mrs. Schaeffer was elected to the township board of trustees in 1968. She was also a member of the beautification commission and housing commission for the city.

"The council is losing a very valued member and the community is gaining a very capable person," Mayor Fred Lichtman said. "I wish her well on the bench."

Mrs. Schaeffer was not present at the council meeting.
