

# St. Owen gets European bells

The sound of church bells is part of every European traveler's memories and now a little bit of Europe has come to the Franklin area.

Mr. and Mrs. Edward K. Sampson of Birmingham were impressed during a recent trip by the lovely sound of church bells that they wanted to share it with their church members.

Beginning the weekend of Dec. 7 the newly installed bells of St. Owen have been tolling the hours of noon and 6 p.m.

The Church of St. Owen, 6869 Franklin Road, is a pagoda-style building with the bell tower in the pinnacle.

**THE THREE** cast bronze bells are visible in the tower.  
The Schulmerich-Eijbouts bells were cast in Asten, Holland, and shipped from Rotterdam to Detroit Harbor Terminal on the Tilly Russ arriving Nov. 22.

Each bell has eight harmonic tones which is sounded electronically from a console on the second floor of the church. The are set to automatically sound at the two hours and also may be sounded manually.

The largest, weighing 419 pounds, is named "The Wedding of Canaan." The second, 282 pounds, is "The Playing Children" and the third with a weight of 216 pounds is called "Four Evangelists, Mat-

thew, Mark, Luke and John."

According to the Rev. Edward P. Walling, pastor, the bells were named following a centuries-old custom.

**ENGINEERS FROM** the works in Holland with engineers from Schulmerich Carillons, Inc., Sellersville, Pa., worked for several days to insure proper installation of the bells.

"If they are not hung properly they will not sound the right note," Dorothy McDonald, church secretary, explained. "There is a mark inside the bell indicating where the tongue should strike for each sound."

The bells were on display at the

church before they were installed so members could see the inscription of the donor's name along with the church name and date of installation.

The bells were blessed at the Thanksgiving Eve service by Father Walling. He explained that people originally thought the bells gave forth the sound of God's voice beckoning people to come to church.

Later they were used to remind people to come in from the fields for the worship hour.

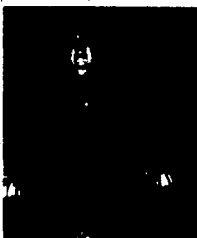
Mrs. McDonald said the bells and the new pipe organ will make this Christmas a memorable one for the members of St. Owen.
