# Kidnapping suspect arrested by police

**SOUTHFIELD**—A Detroit youth is being held on 10 counts of armed robbery and kidnapping involving five persons in two separate incidents at Northland Shopping Center.

Daryl Lavere Bryant, 17, was arraigned Jan. 2 before Southfield 46th District Court Judge John J. Bryant. He was held at \$1 million. Bryant is in Oakland County Jail pending a Jan. 14 examination before 46th District Court Judge Norman Feder.

Each of the charges carries a possible life sentence. Bryant was out on \$500 bond for an earlier charge of unarmed robbery when the Northland incidents occurred. He was apprehended after investigation by Southfield police officers James Kerr and Donald Szafarski.

Bryant's photograph was identified by the victims including Mrs. Patricia Whelan, 37, of Oak Park and her two teenage daughters who were ap-

proached by two males in the Northland parking lot about 4:15 p.m. Dec. 28, according to police.

MRS. WASHBURN told police the men warned her and her daughters not to scream and to get into their car. One of the suspects produced a small handgun, forced the mother and daughters into the car and the other suspect drove to the Livonia area in Detroit, police said.

The three victims were dropped off at Potomac and the Lodge service drive, according to police, and the suspects drove off with their purses which contained credit cards and a small amount of cash.

Bryant was also identified by Nadine Papke, 20, of Livonia and Michael Janette, 23, of Wixom who were approached by two men in the Northland parking lot about 7 p.m. Dec. 30.

Janette told police he was letting Miss Papke into his car when the armed suspects ordered the couple to enter the 1974 Oldsmobile and drove to the Fenkell-Livonia area.

According to police, the suspects pulled into a side street, went through Miss Papke's purse, forced the couple out of the car and stole a watch, eyeglasses and \$80 in cash.

The identity of the second suspect is still under investigation, according to police.

# 6th person robbed at mall

**SOUTHFIELD**—A 70-year-old Detroit woman became the sixth victim of armed robbery and abduction at Northland Shopping Center in a week.

Mrs. Amy Friday told police she was approached by two suspects in the Northland parking lot at 3:45 p.m. Jan. 6. She said she agreed to drive the men to Nine Mile and Lahser roads. One man told Mrs. Friday he had a gun, ordered her to pull over to the side of the street and get into the back seat while he drove, according to police.

The suspect drove around about 45 minutes, turned onto Plum Brook Street in Southfield and ordered Mrs. Friday out of her car, police said. The hold-up men drove away in the victim's 1973 Oldsmobile after taking her purse containing \$37, police said.

On Dec. 29 and 30, five victims were kidnapped and robbed at gunpoint in two separate incidents at Northland.
