## Dems Invite F'ton Judge Candidates

All candidates for district judge have been invited to appear before the monthly meeting of the Farmington Democratic Club.

The meeting is scheduled for 8 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 1, at the new Farmington Democratic headquarters, 3312 Grand River—the former Elks Temple and City Hall.

Farmington Democratic Club Chairman Gerald Freedman welcomed all area residents to attend the meeting to hear what the various candidates have to say about how they would run this newly-created judicial office.

The district court, newly created by the Legislature, will serve both the city and township of Farmington and will replace the present Municipal Court in the city and the justices of the peace in the township.

Invited to appear have been Michael Hand, Bernard Kahn, Robert Nelson and Earl Oppenheimer.

## Opposition To Special Tax Voiced

Members of the Oakland County Homeowners and Taxpayers Association are being urged to vote against the one-mill road tax levy at next Tuesday's election, a director of the organization has announced.

Charles Buck, who made the announcement, criticized campaign literature issued by a group called Citizens for Adequate Roads, which advocates adoption of the millage.

"We can't understand why the county has money for luxuries like a \$6.5 million jail and a \$30 million building program, but none for necessities," said Buck.

"We can't understand why they won't allow us to vote on spending money for airports, but come to us for more money for necessities the people must have."

"The government first takes what it wants of our tax dollar for its building programs, which leaves the people shorted on what they need. The people are then forced to vote more taxes in order to have minimum necessities like roads."

"Economizing should be done by the person who spends the money as well as by the guy who supplies it."

## City Tree Planting Studied

The Farmington Beautification Committee took the occasion of the Festival parade as a means to publicly kick off its Tree Planting Program in the city.

Preliminary plans call for the program to get underway by the fall of 1968.

With this in mind the committee is conducting a survey to determine the best type of trees that grow in various neighborhoods.

In advance planning for the project the committee has met with Concerto Alberto, landscape architect for the Oakland Landscape Co. of Southfield, and Gordon Dennis, district extension horticulture agent for Wayne County.
