

Harrison stops Churchill

Holcomb, Hatch pace Raider tankers

Led by double winners Mark Holcomb and Jordan Hatch, North Farmington defeated Pontiac Central, 106-86, in a non-league swimming meet last Thursday.

Hatch won the 200-yard freestyle (1:32.3) and the 100 freestyle (51.0). Holcomb took the 200 individual medley (2:12.2) and the 500 freestyle (5:13.2, school record). Both Holcomb and Hatch swam on Harrison's winning 400 freestyle relay, which was clocked at 3:38.5.

The victory gave coach Pat Dutch's North Farmington team a 25 record this season.

Earlier last week, Rochester Adams beat North Farmington, 110-62, in another non-league meet.

Farmington Harrison defeated Lavonia Churchill, 93-73, in a Western Six League swim meet last Thursday. Harrison is 4-0 in the league, and 6-2 overall.

Mark Pearson and Nick Hawthorne were double winners for the Hawks. Pearson took the 200 freestyle (1:56.6)

and the 500 freestyle (5:20.0). Hawthorne won the 50 freestyle (1:24.2) and the 100 freestyle (52.6).

Stevenson tops FHS, 58-51

All signs point to a Jan 31 showdown for the Inter-Lakes basketball championship. George VanWagoner's Stevenson Spartan club remained one step behind Pontiac Northern in the title chase by knocking down a spirited Farmington Falcon charge, 58-51.

The game was closer than expected, commented the Stevenson head mentor "But we will take it!" Stevenson is now 4-1 in the Inter-Lakes with that solo defeat coming at the hands of unbeaten Pontiac Northem (62-51).

On Jan. 31, the Spartans will have the Hawks of Northern in Stevenson country in what should shape up to be the deciding clash.

Overall the Spartans are now 8-4 and travel to Plymouth Canton for a non-league game tomorrow (Tuesday) and to Waterford on Friday.

Stevenson jumped off to a 21-10 first quarter lead over Farmington, hitting seven of 12 from the floor. Jim Gilland hitting for eight and John Bonby for seven.

The second eight minutes saw Farmington connect on eight of eight from the field and the Stevenson margin was sliced to 33-29 at the half.

Farmington took the third quarter, 19-27 lead with 3:10 left in the contest. The Falcons took a 48-45 lead.

Rob Ross tied it up at 48-all for Stevenson and Bonby hit on a 10-footer for the go ahead bucket. The Spartans proceeded to outscore Farmington, 10-3 in the last two minutes.

Stevenson wound up 23 of 48 from the floor for 48 per cent. Farmington far excelled in this department, hitting on 24 of only 39 shots for 62 per cent.
