

Stevenson icers top Jays, 6-2

Livonia Stevenson defeated Southfield High, 6-2, last Friday in a Suburban Hockey League game in which the penalties were more prominent than the scoring plays.

Players from both teams spent a total of 34 minutes in the penalty box. That total doesn't include the two misconducts called. The penalty summary may look bad, but the game wasn't really that rough, according to Southfield coach Art Carinci.

"They were very close calls," he said. "He (the referee) didn't want the game to get out of hand, so he called it very tight for both teams."

Stevenson's Jerry DiRusso scored at 1:18 of the first period, then added another at 2:18 of the second. Doug Smith fired in a goal in between DiRusso's markers.

Southfield's Dana Bonino scored from Pete Bruder and Greg Earl at 13:33 of the second period, and Russ Doyle scored an unassisted goal at 10:14 of the third. Stevenson put the game out of reach with third-period goals by Doug Finn, Bob Fontana and Gerry Zich.

"OUR TEAM was so disorganized," said Carinci, whose team is 2-5-1 including last week's loss. "I don't know if it was the unfamiliar surroundings of the rink (Ford Ice Arena in Livonia) or what. I'm not making excuses for them, but this is only our second league game down here."

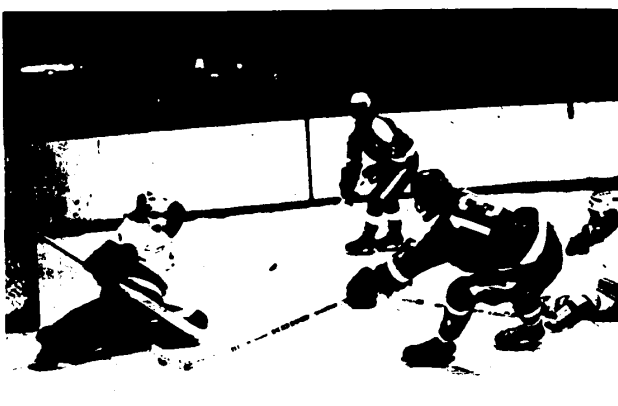

"Stevenson, on the other hand, was playing well, pressing and forechecking. I think that was the key: they were forechecking and applying a lot of pressure in our zone."

Southfield plays next at home against Wyandotte on Thursday (Jan. 23). The game begins at 8 p.m. at the Beechwood Arena.

Offensively, one of our problems is that we're not pressing enough in our zone," Carinci said. "I don't like to de-emphasize defense, but from now on I'm going to stress offense a little more. We've got to get to the attack a little better."

Only five more games remain in the regular season after the Wyandotte contest. Four of those remaining games will be played on the road.

Livonia Franklin scored three goals in the second period and stopped Southfield-Lathrup, 5-1, in a Suburban Hockey League game last Friday.

Lathrup opened the scoring at 12:17 of the first period when Mike McCullough scored an unassisted goal. Lathrup looked good in the opening period, but Franklin dominated the rest of the way, according to Charger coach Dave Butler.

"Our kids came to play in the first period, but we kept on making the same mistakes," he said. "Most of our mistakes are caused by our own mental lapses."

"I tell our players that we're

always playing two teams: ourselves and the opposition. We can't afford those mental errors because we're not that good ability wise."

Franklin centers Mike Garbutt and Mike Barta provided the winners with the scoring punch. Barta scored two goals, while Barta tallied a goal and an assist. Bob Sergison and Stu Said each added goals for the Patriots.

"Franklin's very good around the net," Butler said. "You never catch them out of position."

Lathrup now 0-6-1, plays next on Friday (Jan. 24) against Livonia Bentley. The game is set for 9 p.m. at Livonia's Ford Ice Arena.

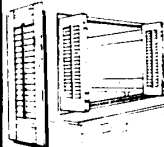

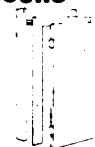
