Named the Brown-Carisen Listening comprehension Test, it evaluates stu-tents on such listening components as mmediate recall, following directions, recognizing transitions and word meanings and lecture com-

It was originally written in 1953 and nay be somewhat out of date due to elinements in testing methods, but i's still helpful, Greenberg said

Again, you have five seconds to answer, but you can't use your pencil to take notes or figure out the numbers.

Naturally, some students don't do as well on the numerical series as they will on lecture comprehension, Greenberg said. There is a lot of vari-ety in ability.

According to the test, the most sig-nificant listening components are emaintaining an awareness of one's own motives in listening, esharing with the speaker responsi-

bility for communication.

• arranging favorable physical conditions for listening.

Also important is exercising emo-tional control during listening, recog-nizing patterns in subject-matter ar-rangement and relating a particular oral presentation to preceding and fol-
