SEMCOG representatives will explain why communities which don't abide by the new legislation will be included by the new legislation will be

According to SEMCOG officials, these communities will also be in-eligible for federal disaster relief funds for flooded areas or federally funded flood insurance.

THE NATIONAL flood insurance program is federally-subsidized and authorized by a 1988 state act. It protects property owners who have been unable to obtain affordable coverage through private insurance companies
