

'Arms of the Man' performed as Community Center benefit

The Farmington Players' winter production, George Bernard Shaw's "Arms of the Man" will be performed as a benefit for the Farmington Community Center on Sunday, Feb. 16. Curtain time is 7:30 p.m.

The satire on war and the professional fighting man opens in the Players Barn on Friday, Feb. 14, and is set to run for three consecutive weeks.

The ticket price for the benefit performance includes an invitation to attend a champagne and hors d'oeuvres afterward at the center, immediately following the performance. The tickets, \$8.50 each, are on sale now at the center.

THIS IS THE second time the boards of directors of the two groups have joined to benefit the community center. A benefit date is expected to

be included in all upcoming productions.

When the benefit was introduced last fall, the center profited with a sell-out. Using the same format, the cast members will attend the afterglow to meet their audience.

Playing to sold-out houses is not new to the Farmington Players. Doctors Shevlin, who handles the ticket sales for the group, said that season ticket holders account for such a bulk of the sales that an additional date, Thursday, Feb. 20, was added to this season's performance dates to accommodate the general public.

All tickets for the Thursday, Feb. 27, performance have been purchased by members of the Universalist-Unitarian Church in Farmington.

THE EIGHT MEMBER cast of "Arms of the Man" is Karl Beddow, Daryne Hummon, Jill Haze, Bob Shaw, Gordon Paul, John Powers, Don Craig and Ron Clemmer.

The play is directed by Bob Case, more, who is assisted by Peggy Sisto. Producer is Sal Sisto.

The Players Barn is at 32332 W. Twelve Mile, between Orchard Lake and Farmington Roads.

Mental patients group will form for action

A former social worker put out a call this week for the formation of a new group to be called "Mental Patients Action Group." He is asking for participation from mental patients, their families and friends to work on a five part series of actions centered around a law which went into effect last November concerning admission and discharge procedures of those with mental illnesses.

STEVE RICE will hold his first meeting on Tuesday, Feb. 11, at 7:30 p.m. in Farmington's Universalist-Unitarian Church, at 25401 Halstead Road, just north of Grand River.

Guest speaker at the first meeting will be Richard Budd, assistant superintendent at Northville State Hospital.

Rice explained that the first business at hand would be a testing of the new law by getting testimonials from those who have had experience in the past three months in admitting or discharging patients. These testimonials will be handed over to State Representative R. Robert Geake (R-Northville) for his use in testing the law.

OTHER AIMS of the group will be the investigation of room and board facilities for mental patients in the Detroit area; the quality of care patients receive once in a hospital; the rights of the mental patient; and the formation of a team of volunteers who will work as patient advocates.
