## Judaism institute for clergy set Friday

Temple Beth El's 33rd annual B. Benedict Glazer Institute on Judaism for the Christian Clergymen of Metropolitan Detroit will be held Friday at the Temple.

At the 10 a.m. session in the Maas Chapel, the invocation will be given by Rabbi Jeffrey B. Lazar, educational director of Temple

At the 11:15 a.m. session the presiding chairman will be the Very Rev. Andrew Woronovich of First Eastern Orthodox Church.

**THE LECTURER** will be Rabbi Walter Jacob, spiritual leader of the Rodef Shalom Congregation in Pittsburgh. He will speak on "Emergence of the Dialogue—Its Beginning and Its Problems."

The luncheon session will be held at 12:45 p.m. in Handelman Hall. The invocation will be given by Rabbi Daniel Schwartz.

The presiding chairman will be the Rev. Robert L. Kincheloe, executive director, Metropolitan Detroit Council of Churches.

Rabbi Jacob graduated with honors from Drury College and was ordained with honors from the Hebrew-Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion, where he serves on the board of governors.

**HE ALSO SERVES** on the Commission of Response of the Central Conference of American Rabbis, is president of Associated American Jewish Museums and serves on boards of other national and local organizations. He is visiting professor at Pittsburgh Theological Seminary.

Rabbi Jacob is the author of a number of books, the latest being "Christianity Through Jewish Eyes," and articles in scholarly periodicals.

Dr. Neusner graduated magna cum laude from Harvard College, took post-graduate work at various universities including the Jewish Theological Seminary of America and has a doctor's degree from Columbia University.

Before his association with Brown University, he served as assistant professor of Hebrew at the University of Wisconsin, research associate at Brandeis Uni-

versity and associate professor of religion at Dartmouth College.

A prolific writer, Dr. Neusner is

the author of many books, textbooks, collections of essays and articles in scholarly periodicals.
