Rabbi Jacob graduated with honors from Drury College and-was ordained with honors from the Hebrew-Union College-Jewish In-stitute of Religion, where he serves on the board of governors.

HE ALSO SERVES on the Commission of Response of the Central Conference of American Rabbis, is president of Associated American Jewish Museums and serves on boards of other national and local-organizations. He is visiting professor at Pittsburgh Theological Seminary.

Rabbi Jacob is the author of a number of books, the latest being "Christianisty Through Jewish Eyes," and articles in scholarly periodicals.

Dr. Neusner graduated magna cum laude from Harvard College, took post-graduate work at various universities including the Jewish Theological Seminary of America and has a doctor's degree from Col-umbia University.

Before his association with Brown University, he served as assistant professor of Hebrew at the University of Wisconsin, re-search associate at Brandeis Uni-
