## Economist predicts more unemployment

Unemployment in Michigan will be back to 7.7 per cent-by December if federal tax measures are effected to stimulate the economy, predicts a Michigan State University researcher. David 1. Verway of the Bureau of Business and Economic Research forecasts that unemployment in the state will probably be at 10.7 per cent without the tax cuts. On the national level, by the end of the year, Verway expects six per cent unemployment with the tax measures and 8.1 per cent without them.

He expects unemployment in Michigan to peak at 13.6 per cent next month. This compares with 9.7 per cent unemployment during February
