## Fruehauf seeks foreign trade

Robert D. Rowan, president and chief executive officer of Fruehauf Corp., today announced completion of an agreement with a leading manufacturer of heavy machinery and equipment in Yugoslavia, IMOGOSA of Belgrade, to produce Fruehauf's complete line of over-the-road vehicles and intermodal shipping containers in that country.

Concluded on Feb. 15, in Belgrade, the arrangement was signed by Fruehauf board chairman, William E. Grace, and Alex S. Aranyos, president of Fruehauf International, Limited, who handled negotiations leading to the final agreement. Representing IMOGOSA were B. Cirovic, president, and T. Tomic, executive vice president.

"This agreement could lead to possible capital investment in Yugoslavia," Rowan said. "It is an important agreement for us because it opens a new market for our products, not only in Yugoslavia but in other neighboring socialist countries, and the many

world markets where Yugoslav products are sold."

IMOGOSA, the parent company of IMOGOSA, is one of the leading Yugoslav companies involved in the manufacture of machinery and equipment. It operates seven factories and employs 10,000 people in its Djuro Djakovic and GOSA combine.

Its major products include railroad rolling stock; freight transportation vehicles; processing machinery; heavy industrial structures; thermal and water power plant equipment; structural steel buildings, bridges, etc.; industrial transportation facilities and terminals.

At present, Fruehauf's overseas subsidiaries and affiliates have sales of approximately \$400 million, manufacturing more than 50,000 units and employ 15,000 employees.

Fruehauf Corp. will now have manufacturing operations in 20 countries and sales and service outlets in more than 50 countries of the world.


