

Northville wins league meet --and title

Harrison swimmers won't repeat as champions

An unfortunate thing happened to Farmington Harrison on the way to its third-straight Western Six League swimming title.

Harrison, which compiled an 8-0 league season and a 13-4 overall record, finished second in the league meet last weekend at Livonia Church St. Since the Western Six league is swimming title only on the track in the league meet, Harrison had to settle for second place behind Northville High, which scored 300 points to the Hawks' 292.

Harrison had beaten Northville twice during the regular season, but the Hawks ran into depth problems at the league meet, according to coach Mark Holdridge.

"We just ran out of people," he said. "They had more swimmers. Northville has 30 swimmers, we have 14. Northville had mediocre kids placing pretty well, while we had kids

qualifying for the state meet and finishing first and second."

Plymouth Canton finished third with 178 points, Livonia Church St. and Walled Lake Western scored 81.

The diving event beat Harrison. Northville outscored the Hawks, 41-18, and Mustang divers took the top three spots.

But Harrison swimmers sparkled throughout the meet, winning eight of the 11 events. Jeff Horacek won two events, the 100-yard breaststroke in a league-record 1:04.9 time, and 200-yard individual medley in 2:07.4. He also swam on the 200 medley relay team, which set a league record of 1:44.5.

Harrison's Steve Scheff, a junior, set a league record in the 100 butterfly with a 1:30.0 timing. Other Harrison winners: Jeff Arnold in the 200 freestyle (1:30.3), Chris Hoobler in the 500 freestyle (8:10.2), and Dave Humphries in the 100 backstroke (1:50.4).

Northville set a league record in the 200 freestyle relay with a 3:28.9 effort.

Farmington High compiled 174 points and finished fourth in the Intra Lakes League swimming meet last weekend at Bloomfield Hills Andover.

Andover won nine of 11 events and scored 483 points to top the meet. Livonia scored 322 points, second with 248 Walled Lake Central had 198 and Pontiac Northern 94. Milford Lakeland does not have a swimming team.

Farmington's 400-yard freestyle relay team of Mark Tompkins, Bruce Spjeldet, Ron Reiske and Ken Gutowick combined for a third-place finish of 3:44.4. Tompkins set a school record in the 500 freestyle while taking fourth in 5:27.8.

Reiske took third in the 100 freestyle (1:41.4) and Steve Bill Burrows also finished fourth. George Dorset took sixth in the 100 backstroke (1:05.9).

"Everybody had the best times of their lives except for a couple of guys," said Farmington coach Jack Merritt, completing his first season as Falcon coach.
