

Trackmen face busy spring at Christian

The members of Southfield Christian's track team should know that the sport is all about by the end of the season.

This is the age of specialization in track, but at Christian "everybody's going to be doing everything," according to first-year coach Tichner, who is facing his first season with just 18 trackmen on his varsity squad.

The reason for the slim turnout is that Christian will field a basketball team this spring, and there just don't seem to be enough athletes to go around at the Class D school.

Tichner took over the track duties from Dave Guthrie, who departed for Bethany Christian High School in Troy. Tichner started practice early, entering some of his charges in several indoor meets at Eastern Michigan University and the University of Michigan.

Christian has a 15-month schedule which includes weekend meets in the state regional and the state Class D meet at Caro High School. Christian begins its season April 7 at home against Detroit St. Andrew. Six teams dual meets are scheduled for Christian's track, which is based at the school at 2800 Lehigh Road.

Tichner comes to Christian with an unusual background. The 26-year-old New York City native, who taught French at Christian. He has studied at Paris University, and now is taking graduate courses in foreign languages and education at Wayne State University.

Tichner was a track standout during his days at Upstate, and still participates in the sport on the AAU level. He and his wife live in Royal Oak.

Former Raider ends tank career

Dan McLean, a graduate of North Farmington High School, closed out his collegiate swimming career at Western Michigan University with two individual school records, and also helped smash three records in relays.

McLean broke the records he set last season in the 100 and 200 yard butterfly at the Mid-American Conference championships held recently. His time in the 100 was :37.77, good for eighth place in the championships. His 2:01.77 clocking in the 200 put him in 10th place.

McLean was a member of the 400 and 800-yard freestyle relay teams which established school records. He also swam a leg on the 800-yard medley relay.

The 5.8, 160-pound McLean also had an outstanding regular season, winning nine individual races and swimming in 12 individual relay teams.

Western Michigan finished fifth in the MAC and compiled an 8-4 record in dual-meet competition.

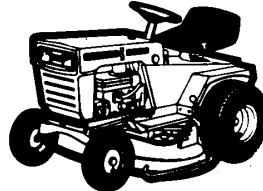
