

# Family Night planned for West Bloomfield

West Bloomfield schools will hold "Family Night Out," Friday April 25 from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m.

Recreational and enrichment programs will be offered to all students and parents in the West Bloomfield school district.

Main attraction is a presentation by Ivan Danosi on "The Art of Fencing" at the high school.

Demonstrations of fencing techniques, electronic foil fencing and matches between champions will highlight the program.

DANOSI, PROFESSOR of Physical Education at Wayne State University, is one of the nation's leading fencing coaches. The fencing champion acted as U.S. coach in the World University Games.

Danosi's son Steve, an NCAA Sabre Champ and candidate for the World Olympics will also appear in the program.

Other champions include seven-time national fencing champion Greg Benko, an Australian representative in the Munich Olympics.

Junior and senior high school champions will compete in the demonstration.

FREE OPEN swim will also be offered at the high school.

Other activities included in "Family Night Out" are free roller skating at Abbott Middle School and a student production of "Starburst" at Orchard Lake Middle School.

Highlights of the elementary school program include Coney Islands at Doherty, a PTA Fair at Ealy and Open recreation plus a father and son basketball game at Green schools.

Also offered will be "The Multiplication Moo-Moo Mystery" at Roosevelt and a Police dog demonstration with open recreation at Scotch School.

FAMILY NIGHT Out is sponsored by the West Bloomfield Community Education Department throughout the academic year.

The program has one stipulation. All youngsters must be accompanied by an adult and all adults bring a youngster in order to be admitted to any of the activities.

The announcement came after the Bloomfield Hills school completed its first basketball season with a 9-3 record.

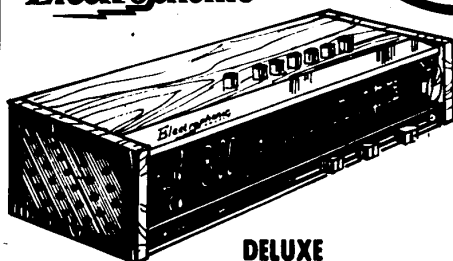

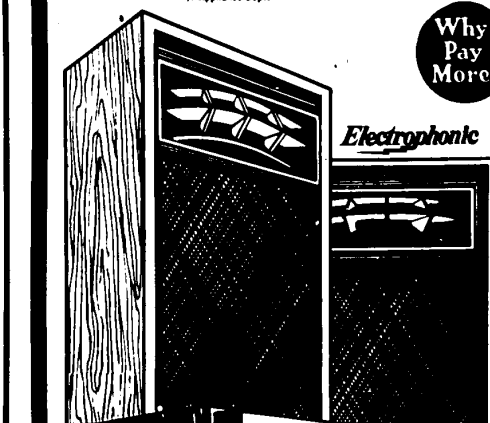

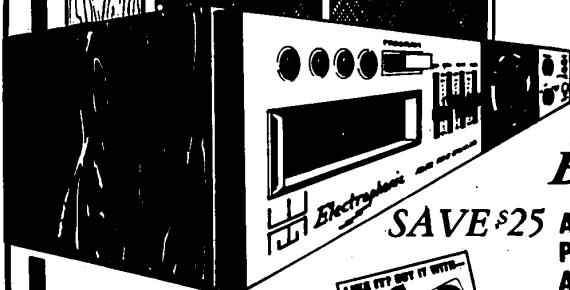
