

Jays, Chargers win tennis meets

Coaches look toward city meet

A lot of tennis must be played before May 23, but coaches at Southfield-Lathrup and Southfield High are looking forward to that date.

Both schools have fine teams this season, and May 23 is the date of their annual intracity clash on Southfield's courts. No. 1 singles should be interesting in that meet. Southfield's Dave Begun and Lathrup's Guy Saperstein are undefeated as of last Thursday.

Both players won matches last week to help their teams keep winning. Southfield defeated Hazel Park, 7-0, in a Southeastern Michigan Association meet. Lathrup stopped non-league Birmingham Seaholm, 4-3.

Begun beat Hazel Park's Bruce Herzog in three sets, 3-6, 6-1, 7-5. In No. 1 doubles, Southfield's Mike Fuller and David Lee defeated Jim Gargus and Tom Hite, 7-6, 3-6, 6-2.

"We thought we'd have a much tougher meet because Hazel Park

played Royal Oak Kimball to 4-3 before losing," said Southfield coach Dale Freeman. "But the Southfield-Hazel Park was closer than the score indicated. No. 1 singles and No. 1 doubles went to three sets. Anytime it goes to three sets, you know it's up in the air."

Saperstein defeated Seaholm's Pete Blake, 6-3, 6-4. In No. 1 doubles, Seaholm's Sandy Dickerson and Jeff Muhn beat Ken Silver and Rick Snyder. The victory lifted the Chargers to 6-0 this season.

Lathrup plays next on Monday (April 28) at home against Royal Oak Dondoro in an MSA meet. The Chargers' April 23 meet at Utica Eisenhower was rained out.

Southfield, 4-1 so far with the loss to Seaholm, plays next on Monday at Ferndale High in an SMA contest. The Blue Jays move on to Royal Oak Kimball (which beat Seaholm) for a dual meet on May 1.
