

SAG sets summer gymnastics program

The Southfield Association for gymnastics (SAG) will hold its fifth annual summer gymnastics workshop at

Southfield's Birney Junior High School beginning June 23. Registration will be held June 7 in the corridor of the physical education wing at Southfield-Lathrup High School from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. The workshop will consist of two three-week sessions: June 23 to July 11, and July 14 to Aug. 1. Beginning and low-intermediate classes will meet daily from 9-11 a.m. Intermediate and advanced classes will be held from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. daily. All students in the workshop will receive instruction in tumbling, trampolining, vaulting and apparatus. The boys' apparatus includes pommel horse, high bar, parallel bars and still rings. Girls will work on balance beam and uneven parallel bars. Joe Bellan, a physical education teacher in the Southfield school system, will direct the workshop this year. His staff includes Ken Avis (boys' apparatus), Debi Kastner

(girls' apparatus), Sharon Bernales (girls' apparatus), Gary Schmidt (boys' and girls' trampoline), and Jim Holt (tumbling).

TOT TUMBLING, a new SAG program, will be held daily from 100 at Birney. Boys and girls from four to five years of age will be instructed in basic coordination movement and tumbling stunts. The tots will use low balance beams, trampolines and floor mats.

Maxine Ceccato and Agnetha Karlsson, both experienced gymnasts, will teach the tots. Mini Williams will assist them.

Miss Ceccato, who competed in gymnastics while at Michigan State University, will assist in the intermediate and advanced classes. In addition to Miss Karlsson, who is visiting from Sweden, SAG will sponsor Jytte Poulsen of Denmark, and Margaretha Liljestam of Sweden. All the gymnasts have extensive backgrounds in gymnastics competitors and coaches.

Tuition fees start at \$17.50 per session for each child in a family in the tot tumbling program. The fee is \$27.50 per session for one child in the other workshop programs. Special rates are available parents enroll

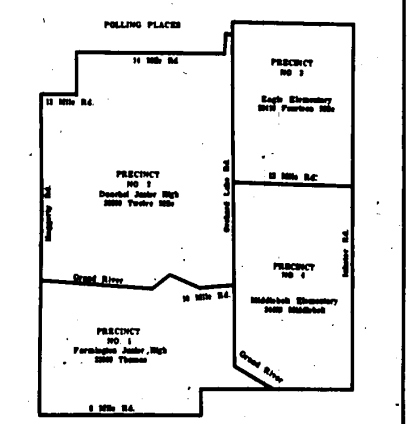
