Refurbished office has open house

On Sunday, June 23, metropolitan area persons will have an opportunity to see what can be done with one of the city's old buildings.

Along with the second annual Harrogate Park art fair, the public will be able to visit the three-story building, 100 Centre St.

Long considered a liability and destined for demolition to make way for a parking lot, the building was a turn-of-the-century furrier's warehouse.

The entire rehabilitation cost including work for tenants, built-in furniture and planned exterior and site work was \$112,000 or approximately \$22.80 per square foot.

The first floor is leased to Pota and Plants, Inc. The second floor houses the law firm of Halpern, Mogil, Bush, Pomeroy and Wales, the building architect, John Hildebrand and Susan Krumholz, Inc., have studios on the third floor.

The facade has been kept without change except for cleaning and painting. Walls, floors, structure, windows and mechanical system have been kept and exposed wherever practical.

An opening was made in the third floor to provide a two-story recreation room extending from the second floor to the skylights. The original skylights have been painted and reglazed.

NEW CONSTRUCTION is of low-cost interior materials—tile trim, natural birch wall coverings, cedar buttons, natural finish oak and pine built-in furniture. The ceiling is of dropped theatrical metal. The original brick walls have been sandblasted and the original pine windows repaired, stained and oiled.

The project is already playing a key role in the revitalization of the Harrogate Park area. Since the building has been abandoned, residents on several others in the area have begun.

State will widen Grand River Ave.

Rough sections of Grand River Avenue may be repaired this summer by the State Highway Department, Farmington city officials believe.

City manager Robert Dendman said recently the state plans to widen Grand River to five lanes and resurface it.

The whole project, which won't be completed until next year, has been divided in two. The stretch of roadway from I-96 and Grand River to I-96 and Drake Road will be widened to five lanes and resurfaced.

The cost of the first half of the project is estimated at \$600,000.

The second project, from Drake Road eastwardly three miles to east of Helen Road, will cost \$800,000.
