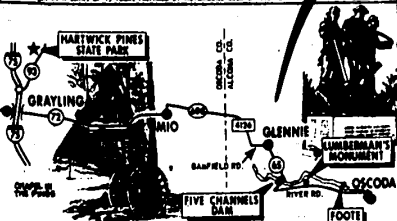


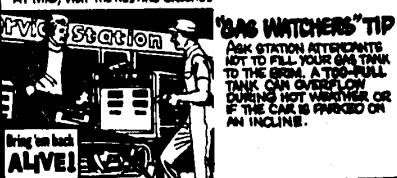
Tour Michigan to find waterfalls, sand dunes

TOUR MICHIGAN FIRST



JOURNEYING ALONG THE AU SABLE RIVER

...FROM GRAYLING TO OSCODA WILL GIVE VACATIONERS A FEEL FOR HOW MICHIGAN LOOKED WHEN INDIANS, RATHER THAN TOURISTS, PADDOLED ITS STREAMS. THE 50-MILE DRIVE ALONG THIS HEAVILY FORESTED, MAJESTIC RIVER SHOULD BE PRECEDED BY SOME GREAT EATING AT GRAYLING. THAT CITY'S TOP ATTRACTION IS HARTWICK PINES STATE PARK, SITE OF THE LOWER PENINSULA'S LAST LARGE STAND OF VIRGIN PINE. OTHER GRAYLING ATTRACTIONS INCLUDE THE 1920S MAIN HIGHWAY AND THE LITTLE ROCKY MOUNTAIN. AT OSCODA, VISIT THE HISTORIC GRINDING



Waterfalls, sand dunes, multi-colored sandstone cliffs and a ghost town highlight a 100-mile circular tour through the east central Upper Peninsula, according to Automobile Club of Michigan.

Starting from St. Ignace, the tour route first goes to the majestic Tahquamenon Falls. The first stop is the Senny National Wildlife Refuge, where animals from bears to bald eagles are protected, followed by a boat up to the Lake Superior sand dunes at Grand Marais.

Still more Lake Superior scenery awaits visitors at Munising, the western end of the Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore. From Munising, the tour heads south to two state parks—Payette with its ghost town and Palms Beach, site of an intriguing building spring. The tour returns to St. Ignace along the scenic Lake Michigan shore.

Visitors will see not one, but two cascades at the Tahquamenon Falls State Park. The Upper Falls, more commonly known as the Big Falls, has a sheer drop of 40 feet and a width of 300 feet at the crest. The Lower Falls consist of a series of short drops and rapids.

TO CAPTURE the full beauty and drama of the falls—the second largest east of the Mississippi—visitors should not only hike through the state park but also approach them from the water. Excursion boats to Tahquamenon Falls are available at either St. Ignace or Hullett.

The Tonserville Trolley picks up passengers at St. Ignace for a narrow-gauge railroad trip to the Tahquamenon River, where a boat is boarded to ride to the falls. The round trip takes 6 1/2 hours. Fare is \$5 for adults and \$2.50 for children; youngsters under five are free.

A 4 1/2 hour boat ride—the Tonserville Riverboat—takes off from St. Ignace's Landing near Hullett. The cost is \$4.50 for adults, \$2.50 for children and no charge for riders under five.

Both enterprises offer daily excursions through early October.

More than 200 species of birds nest at Senny National Wildlife Refuge, south of Senny. Visitors might sight such animals as musk and otters, too.

If they take a suggested auto tour through the refuge.

THERE IS no admission charge to the 10,000-acre preserve, which also in-

cludes picnic areas, boat trails, fishing spots and a visitor's center.

A different terrain awaits travelers at Grand Marais, which, with its sand dunes, has aptly been called a "north-

ern Sahara." The beach between Grand Marais and Au Sable Point is a rockhounds' delight. Charter boats are available at Grand Marais for "deep sea" fishing in Lake Superior.

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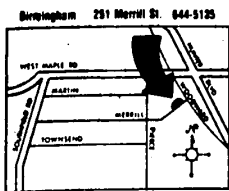
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
