

U of M honors students

Dozens of area students were among some 8,000 University of Michigan students recognized at the university's 52nd annual convocation before the spring Mary Judd.

Almost all of the students received class honors, recognizing an undergraduate academic record equal to at least half A's and half B's for two terms (one term for new students) during 1974.

A total of 894 students were named James B. Angell Scholars. They have maintained an all-A record for top or more consecutive terms as undergraduates.

In addition, 308 members of the freshman class received the William J. Branstrom Prize, a book of their choice bearing the U-M seal and a bookplate. The recipients of the Branstrom prize ranked in the top five per cent of their class.
