# Festival has pair of races

Routes of two different kinds will be important to racers who participate in a pair of Farmington Founders Festival events.

For runners, a 10-mile "mini-marathon" is planned for Saturday, July 26. For car road race enthusiasts, a road rally is scheduled for Sunday, July 27.

The mini-marathon will begin at 9 a.m. July 26 in the Farmington Hills city hall parking lot on Eleven Mile west of Orchard Lake.

It is open to all amateur athletes, male and female. There will be an open class for those under 40, and a masters class for those older than 40.

Entry blanks are available from Farmington Mini-Marathon Race.

Contests are to report to the Farmington Hills city hall at 8:15 a.m. Transportation for belongings to the finish line will be provided.

The route of the race is: west on Eleven Mile to Power; north on Power to Orchard Ridge; left on driveway to Farmington Road; north on Farmington Road to Thirteen Mile; west on Thirteen Mile to Drake; south on Drake Road to Grand River; east on Grand River to Shiawassee; east on Shiawassee to Power; south on Power to Grand River, and west on Grand River to the finish line at Farmington Road.

The route of the "Phrankly Phun XII" road rally is to be deciphered by contestants.

Registration for the rally will be from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. July 27 at the west end of the Westbrook Shopping Center at Thirteen Mile and Orchard Lake.

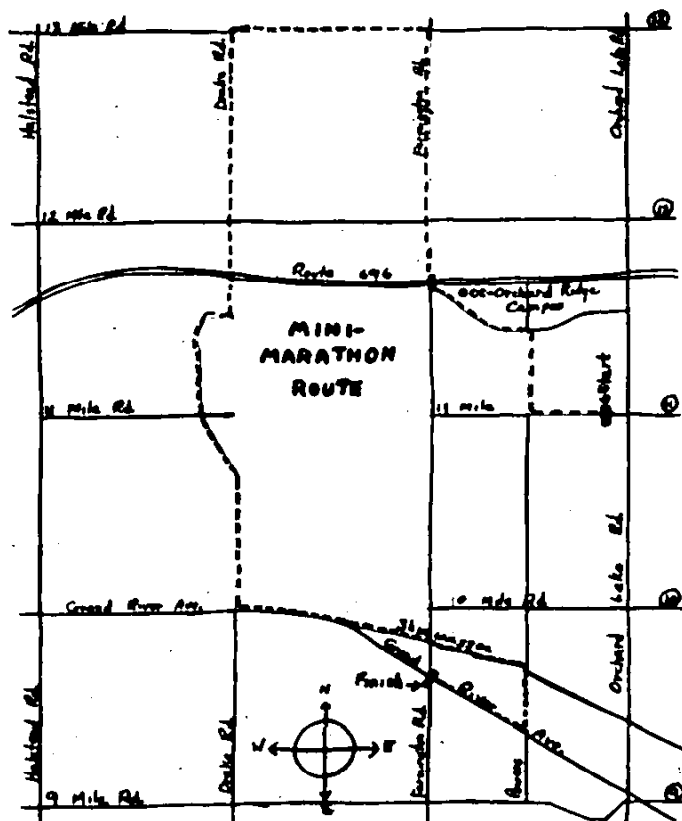
There is an entry fee of \$4.50 per car.

There will be two classes, novice and experienced.

The novice route is 60 miles long, 90 per cent on paved roads. There is point-to-point mileage reporting over the "interesting but not baffling" course.

The experience class route is over a more challenging but not expert course. The route is 75 miles, 75 per cent of which is on paved roads.

Sponsors will return 80 per cent of the net receipts to the top 15 per cent of entrants.



## Softball teams play for Festival title

A slo-pitch softball tournament the weekend of July 25-27 at the Drake Park baseball diamond, on Drake between Grand River and Freedom roads, will be a feature of the Farmington Founders Festival.

According to tournament director Tom Donoghue, action will begin at 6 p.m. Friday, July 25, and run until 11 p.m. Saturday's games will run from 8 a.m. to 11 p.m. Games on Sunday will begin at 9 a.m. with the championship games scheduled for 5 p.m.

Games will be played with American Softball Association (ASA) rules and will be officiated by ASA umpires. The tournament will be played on a two-game elimination basis.

Trophies will be awarded to all members of the first- and second-place teams, with team trophies to be presented to the first three teams. An all-star team and most valuable player will be selected by Donoghue and his assistants, Bill Taylor and Myles Kearney.
