Sunday features family fun

Entertainment ranging from old-fashioned games to space-age electronics will be featured in "Sunday in the Park," a family picnic which will be 1-6 p.m. Sunday, July 27, in the city park at Shiawassee and Power.

"Sunday in the Park" will begin with a bicycle celebration as families ride bikes down Power Road from the Orchard Ridge east faculty parking lot to the city park. The bicycle cele-

bration leaves the Orchard Ridge Campus at 1 p.m.

For those who prefer waiting in the park to riding down Power, the Oakland County Show Troop will entertain on the Showmobile from 1-3 p.m.

Among the other highlights of this old-fashioned family picnic will be games reminiscent of yesteryear. Games will be divided into appropriate age groups with prizes awarded.

Included in the prizes are dinner for two at Blakeney's for the husband-wife water balloon toss team winner.

Other prizes from area merchants include free car washes at the Boron Mini-Man car wash. Evan Bageris of the Farmington Area Recreation Commission will run the games from 2-5 p.m.

Hot dogs, pop and cotton candy will be available at old-time prices, courtesy of Blakeney's. Free skating on the Oakland County Skatmobile will be available from 2-4 p.m.

Other highlights include the second annual bagel eating contest at 2 p.m. on the Showmobile, sponsored by the Detroit Bagel Co.

At 3 p.m. on the tennis courts, Merri-5 will demonstrate radio-controlled flying gasoline model airplanes and radio-controlled cars. Models will be distributed free to the audience at random.

Topping off the family fun will be an old-fashion sing-along presented in cooperation with the Farmington Community Arts Council's summer concert series.

Featured groups include the Sweet Adelines Chorus, the Barbershop Quartettes, the Square Roots and the Met-rochords.

All participants in games must report to the entry table to receive a color-coded emblem which must be displayed in order to participate in events. The schedule of events listed is tentative and will depend upon the number who enter. Changes in starting times will be announced over a loud speaker.

Events include: 2 p.m., boys' three-legged race; 2:15 p.m., girls' three-legged race; 2:30 p.m., father-son (three-legged race); 2:45 p.m., mother-daughter three-legged race; 3 p.m., boys' backward crab race; 3:15 p.m., girls' backward crab race; and 3:30 p.m., husband-wife water balloon toss.

Other events are: 3:45 p.m., father-son one foot skip relay; 4 p.m., Hoops Hoop roll; 4:30 p.m., sack jump take; 4:45 p.m., parent-child wheelbarrow race; 5 p.m., boys' Frisbee accuracy toss, and 5:30 p.m., girls' Frisbee accuracy toss.

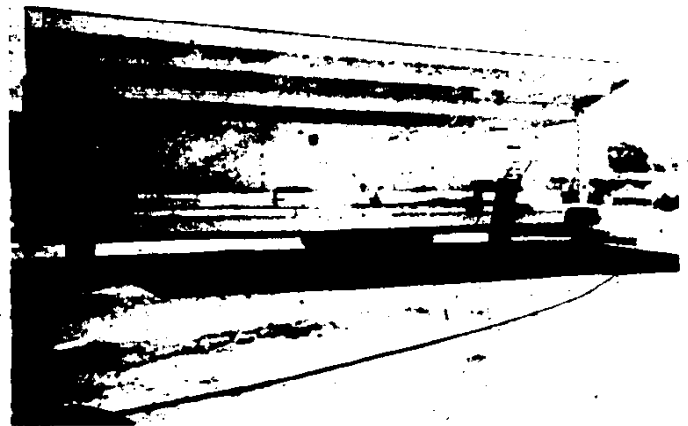
