

# Farmington Hills council passes lease resolution

FARMINGTON HILLS—The city council, hoping to complete construction before cold weather hits, has passed a resolution of intent to enter into a lease with the city building authority for erection of a public works facility.

The action permits the authority to go ahead with allotment of bids for

such preliminary work as excavation and grading.

Council action authorizing full construction bidding is anticipated at next week's meeting.

However, such action would not become effective legally for 45 days to allow time for any unexpected request for a voter referendum.

The 19,500-square-foot steel and brick structure will be located on West Halsted between 14th and 12 Mile Road. Cost will be in the neighborhood of \$600,000.

The building will not be used solely as a storage garage for department of public services vehicles, according to City Manager George L. Majors. It also will provide maintenance and repair of police, fire and other public transport.

Office space will be assigned for the department's foreman, road maintenance supervisor and secretary.

The council also voted to purchase additional equipment for the public services department at its Monday meeting. All were accepted on the lowest bids.

They were a 3/4-ton pickup truck at \$4,380 from GMC Truck and Coach Division, two-door sedans at \$3,860 from Greenfield American, and a 3/4-ton van at \$4,180 from Town and Country Dodge.

The public service facility will be the city's first construction under the newly formed building authority.

The authority has the right to issue construction bonds without voter approval. Bonds are paid off as rent from the city's general funds.
