The artist sent the President the artist's proof of a new serigraph, "Cross Country," a lone skier silhouetted on a wintry scene of pines. It was dedicated "to President Ford who was the inspiration for this painting."

Ford responded graciously saying, "Thank you so much for sending the framed first proof of 'Cross Country.' I am most grateful for the friendship which prompted you to remember me with this example of your talent."

Shaye's work is in the Michigan Art Train, Ford Auditorium and more than 1,000 public and private collections in the country.

A successful businessman, Shaye studied art at the Society of Arts and Crafts in Detroit and donates much of the income from his artistic output to charity.


