Do children learn more from parents or teachers? Specialists at Michigan State University (MSU) say parents play the primary role in socializing a child.

In 1968, MSU began testing Parents Are Teachers Too (PTT. This program, now being used across the state, emphasizes the importance of the parent-child relationship.

"We want to expand and extend the quality and quantity of the time parents spend with their children, says Dr. Robert Boyle founder as the program and direc-tor of MSU's Institute for Family and Child Study.

The program consists of lessons designed to increase parent-child interaction.

PTT involves parents in con-structing easy and inexpensive toys for their children. Series of carefully designed lessons help develop the child's motor and men-tal skills. He has fun, while mommy and daddy teach him.

As parents and children play together, a good-happy relation-ship develops between them. Chil-dren learn through play. PTT teaches parents a wide variety of games and activities that are inter-esting and challenging to the child.

"MY HUSBAND and I both attended the series and our boy really looked forward to each ses-sion," said one mother.

sion," said-one mother.
"We learned to atress the positive with our, children," another
mother said, "I discovered we had
the same problems with our child
as other parents had. At PIT, we
discussed ways to get our children
to eat and go to bed without punishing them."

Research has shown that the child develops a more positive view of himself and of his mother's atti-tude towards him by participating in the program.


The program, which developed after seven years of research, was originally tested with Head Start families (both rural and urban). Now it is being used in many day care centers throughout the state. Soon social workers, home econmists, public health workers, etc. will be able to administer PTT.


