Camp Fire Girls gets Kresge grant

A \$10,000 grant from the Kresge Foundation marks the first major gift received by Camp Fire Girls Detroit Area Council since its recent inauguration of an all-out fund-raising campaign.

This gift will go toward construction of a 24-person winterized cabin at Camp Wathana, the council's resident facility near Holly.

The Kresge grant activates a capital gift arrangement available to Camp Fire through the United Foundation, of which it is a member agency. Together the Kresge and United Foundation funds will subsidize construction of the new cabin.

Camp Fire Girls Detroit Area Council is currently engaged in a capital improvement program at Camp Wathana, a 380-acre site owned and operated by the council. Before the summer of 1976, it is planned that besides the 24-person winterized unit, additional shower and toilet facilities will be provided

and more acreage acquired to protect Wathana from encroaching "civilization."

The council acquired Camp Wathana property in 1928. There are currently 32 units, six of which are heated and can be used year 'round.

In 1974, eight summer resident camp sessions served 828 girls. During the entire year nearly 5,000 persons used Camp Wathana. School and church groups from throughout the metropolitan Detroit area find this Camp Fire facility a good setting for retreats and nature study sessions. The camp enjoys constant use from Camp Fire members as well.

A late-summer ground breaking is anticipated for the winterized cabin made possible by the Kresge grant in conjunction with United Foundation Capital Fund monies and some additional private gifts.

Camp Fire Girls Detroit Area Council is a volunteer youth agency serving more than 7,000 members in the tri-county area. National Camp Fire, dating from 1910, is the oldest interracial, non-sectarian organization for women in this country.

Bike-a-thon planned to fight leukemia

The kick-off for this year's observance of Michigan Leukemia Week, sponsored by the Children's Leukemia Foundation of Michigan, will be at Oakland University on Sunday. A bike-a-thon, sponsored by the foundation's Michael Stark Chapter, will feature a marathon of bikers on OU's 3.5 mile track.

Pledges are being sought, with all proceeds going to the Children's Leukemia Foundation's research fund, which provides grants toward advancement of treatment in the cases of serious blood disease patients.

The bike-a-thon will begin at 8:30 a.m.

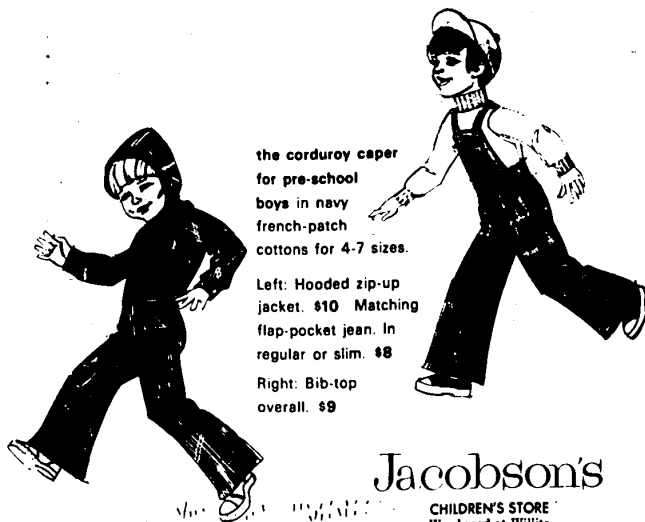
