## Breast lumps ruled 'benign' may not be

int. Evelyn N. Rivera, professor of 20-ology and cancer researcher at Mich-isan State University.

Dr. Rivera holds a three-year re-search grant from the National In-stitutes of Health for studying the transformation of "hyperplantic" tis-sue into "neoplastic" or cancerous tis-sue.

Hyperplastic tissue is believed to be an intermediate between normal and malignant tissue, Dr. Rivera says.

OFTEN NOTICED as a lump in the breast, hyperplastic tissue while not cancerous may contain malignant cells that have not expressed their malignant characteristics.

Tissue transplant experiments in mice show that hyperplastic tissues become cancerous more frequently than transplants of normal tissues, she said, but cancers in laboratory animals are somewhat different than cancers in humans and therefore results


