

# Kirk hosts Scotsman

The Rev. Gilleasbuig I. Macmillan, minister of St. Giles Cathedral in Edinburgh, Scotland, will be guest preacher at Kirk in the Hills on Sunday. Dr. Giles will speak at both the 9:30 and 11:30 a.m. service.

Dr. Macmillan is the youngest minister ever to serve as pastor of the influential St. Giles Cathedrai, where John Knox preached in the early days of the Reformation. Born in Argyll, where his father was minister of two parishes, Dr. Macmillan was named pastor of St. Giles in May 1973.

He attended the University of Edinburgh and received his M.A. with honors in philosophy in 1964 and his hachelor of divinity with honors in systematic theology in 1967. After serving as assistant at St. Michael's church in Linlithgow, he was named minister of the parish of Portree, Isle of Skye, in 1969. During January and February 1972, he visited the Detroit area as ecumenical minister on the staff of the Grosse Pointe Memorial Church.
