JWF appoints division heads

Jewish Welfare Federation President Mandell L. Berman has appointed three people to head the organization's newly reorganized budget and planning divisions.

Mrs. Morris J. Brandwine of Southfield, Avern Cohn of Detroit and Dr. Conrad Giles of Franklin will each chair one of three volunteer groups which make annual reviews of programming and recommendations for allocations to federation beneficiaries.

A fourth planning division, the Capital Needs Committee, will continue its present assignment and responsibilities under the chairmanship of David Handelman of Bloomfield Hills.

Mrs. Brandwine will serve as chairman of Federation's Culture and Education Division, concerned with programming plans of the United Hebrew Schools school system, three area day schools, the Jewish Community Council and the Jewish Community Center.

She has been president of the JWF Women's Division and chairman of the Division's Allied Jewish Campaign-Israel Emergency Fund activity. She has been involved as a board member in the operation of several local federation beneficiaries and is currently a member of the United Jewish Appeal's national Women's Division and of the national board of the Joint Distribution Committee (JDC). JDC is the relief organization which provides services such as housing, food and rehabilitation for distressed Jews around the world.

COHN IS to head the National Agencies Division, responsible for making recommendations for Detroit's allocations to organizations such as Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith, American Jewish Committee and United HIAS. He has been associate chairman of Federation's Community Relations Division.

An attorney and chairman of the Michigan Civil Rights Commission, Cohn is a member of the Detroit Jewish Community Council's executive committee and a national vice-president of the American Jewish Committee. Cohn was a vice-chairman of the 1975 Allied Jewish Campaign-Israel Emergency Fund, the annual fund-raising effort of the federation.

Dr. Giles will be chairman of the Community Services Division, which will supervise a large number of local agencies providing direct service within the Detroit area. The 1973 winner of Federation's Frank A. Wetsman Memorial Leadership Award honoring young communal leaders, Giles

was chairman of the Medical Physicians' Section of the 1974 Allied Jewish Campaign and a director of the Jewish Family & Children's Service. He is on the board of Fresh Air Society, which operates Camp Tamarack.

The three appointees will serve as members of federation's executive committee and a director of the United Jewish Charities, Federation's senior member agency.

BERMAN THANKED the chairmen who have headed Federation's previous budget and planning divisions for the past three years. He said, "The efforts of Community Relations Division Chairman Judge Lawrence Gubow, of Education Chairman Julian S. Tobias, and of Health and Welfare Division Chairman Arnold Faudman are to be most highly commended."

Federation is the central planning organization for Jewish communal agencies which provide services to the Detroit metropolitan area. The Allied Jewish Campaign-Israel Emergency Fund, JWF's annual fund-raising effort, has nearly 25,000 contributors and distributes funds for humanitarian services overseas, nationally and within the local community and regional area.


