

World-farmous Greenfield Village in Dearborn, the vast outdoor museum of Americana founded by auto pieneer Jieruy Ford in 1929, is well along in a Byear expansion plan costing 258 million. The village itself cortains more chan 100 historic structures. Adjoining it is Henry Ford Museum, the village's indoor counterpart.
Back in downtown Detroit, Old Manners' Church on Jefferson Avenue, just east of Henry and Edsel Ford Autorrhim, is the only survivor of 160 buildings razed to make way for the Chvic Center. Built in 1188 this Episcopal church is open to vivitors and guided tours can be booked in advance.
The Civic Center area is a \$100-million. 78-acre development along the Detroit River. Cobo Hall, one of the world's largest, exhibition buildings, contains display areas, assembly halls, a sports arena, duning facilities and rooftop parking.
