The Ronde-View, Michigan's first re-volving restaurant atop the Holiday Inn. offers guests an ever-changing suburban panorama as it gitides through a complete revolution every

Inside the dining and loange areas sparkle in a contemporary decor fashioned by Design House Inc. of Farmington. Louis Sonshine, president of the company, gives a lot of the credit for the interior trappings to his design director. Gary Volz. Sonshine, over hunch in the circular motel tower, said his company doesn't get involved in architecture. He glanced at the curved valances on the windows and explained they were pro-

ing. They're done in four color schemes, and special farnishings were designed to maximize the use of the four color specific courses of the unusual configuration of the rooms. The guest rooms feature supergraphic forest marals, plush shag carpeting and custom screenpristed draperies with matching bedspreads in bold design. Bright accrets of polished chrome and warm wood grains are a change from the ordinary for overnight guests. Sombine said The identity for the lobby and filth floor revolving restaurant was created to separate these areas from the rooms as destinct public space. The said.

A SUPER-GRAPHEC was applied on the 17-foot high walls of the tower lobby in bold tones of plum. crimson and orange to set the mood for the second phase of design. Sombnire said. 
