Nine Mile and Drake Road 300-acre area, hosted city officials and potential clients for a ground and building warming.

When the entire complex is completed, there will be a residential com-

plex of apartments, townhouses and private homes and 77 acres of recreational facilities—a swimming pool (already completed), tennis courts, bike trails, picnic areas, a pond complete with ducks, and plenty of green area and tree lawns.

THE FIRST PHASE, 104 one and two-bedroom apartments and townhouses, is more than 80 per cent occupied.

"We are already formulating construction plans for the second phase in order to meet the growing demand," Uznis said this week.

Construction has already begun on private homes located in the southwest part of the complex.

Rentals range from \$250 for the apartments to \$350 for the townhouses. The monthly rental for a one bedroom apartment, depending on whether it has a patio or balcony and which floor of the three floor buildings, is \$250 to \$285.

Two bedroom apartments range from \$280 to \$315 and the townhouses run from \$350 to \$400.

### Area congregation reinstates Tashlich

With a pond on its own premises, Adat Shalom Synagogue has reinstated the ancient custom of Tashlich.

The Tashlich ceremony is a picturesque ritual, performed on Rosh Hashanah, the Hebrew New Year. It is a symbolic concretization of the verse in the Book of Micah which says, "And thou wilt cast all their iniquities into the depth of the sea."

To perform Tashlich, one goes to a body of running water which has fish in it and, after reciting appropriate prayers, shakes the skirts of one's garments over the water. It is meant to portray an almost physical casting of one's sins upon the water so that they can be carried away and forgotten.

The ritual will be observed 7 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 7. The pond is located at the Thirteenth Mile Road entrance to the synagogue grounds.

A booklet prepared especially for the occasion by the congregation's rabbis will be used. A concluding afternoon and evening Mincha and Ma'ariv services of the festival will follow in the chapel at 7:45 p.m.

The townhouses, however, are three floors—family room and storage on the lower level, living room, dining area and kitchen on the first floor and two bedrooms on the second. There is a half bath on both the lower and first levels and a full bath on the second. Closet and storage space are ample.

According to the zoning established by the Farmington Hills Council, the overall density is to be 4.6 living units per acre with an average of 10 bedrooms to one acre. At least 33 per cent of the total bedrooms must be in the single home part of the community. It was also stipulated that 25 per cent of the total property would be kept green.

"WE ARE PROUD, indeed, to be the forerunners of this imaginative plan," Uznis said, commending the city for foresight in planning and zoning the concept.

The buildings are contemporary in design combining earth-tone brick and stained siding for a natural look that blends with the rolling terrain and

woods in the distance.

The Uznis operation is family-oriented, not only in the designs of the buildings, but in the business itself. Mrs. Uznis, Evelyn, is active, as are sons John and George.

The family has been more than five years in planning the Farmington Hills project.
