In an effort to eliminate the charges and counter charges regarding the "blocking" and "fitting" of lanes to produce high scores across the country, the American Bowling Congress is studying a request to institute a program of sanctioning and certifying equipment used on the lanes. The request was made by a special committee following a meeting with proprietors, along with manufacturers and experts in lane maintenance.

The committee recommended that the ABC establish specifications for the automatic machines. The machines would be certified for use when delivered by the manufacturers and

be inspected for re-certification each year.

The committee also suggested that the ABC commission the development of a device to measure the amount of dressing on a bowling lane and its distribution over the lane.


The action came about when there was an unrealistic number of high scores and high averages—many of which were rejected.
