

# Students sought for adult classes

**Editor's Note:** The Farmington School District is offering a number of courses in the community education program. This is the second in a series of Observer and Eccentric articles on the classes. You may use the accompanying coupon to register. If you've always had a wish to try your hand at drawing or if you've thought it would be fun to explore Japanese "mood" painting, your wish can be granted through the Farmington Community Education program.

Or, if your inclinations lean toward needlework, you can choose from 12 classes offering training for beginner seamstresses to sophisticated pillow work, crewel embroidery and needlepoint.

Classes will be conducted in Farmington High School, 32000 Shawwassee, and last for 10 weeks unless otherwise indicated.

Most classes begin Sept. 22. Registrations will be accepted by mail only at the school before classes begin. Fees are payable at the time of registration.

Senior citizens over 65 years of age will be admitted tuition free to classes of unlimited enrollment. Refunds will be granted for any classes cancelled. All other refund requests must be made to the adult education office before the second class meeting. A \$2 registration fee will be deducted in cases of withdrawal.

Sewing for beginners will provide individual attention and training in the use of the machine layout, cutting, marking, fitting and construction techniques.

Classes will meet at Farmington Junior High in Room 104 on Wednesday from 7-10 p.m. Fee is \$15 and classes are limited in size.

An eight-week course in Bishop 1 sewing will meet Thursday from 7-10

p.m. in room 105A of Farmington High School. Fee is \$15.

The class will teach a beginning sewing method that embodies a technique for making attractive clothing in a minimum of time. The method makes maximum use of the sewing machine and eliminates the use of pins and hand basting.

Another eight-week course is called beginners stitch-the-knits.

Students may make a pair of slacks, a tee shirt and a knit blouse as they learn basic sewing techniques using Bishop methods and knit fabrics.

The class will meet Wednesday from 7-10 p.m. in room 105A of the high school. Fee is \$15.

and what can be done with the building, architecturally.

Green and Associates are different, too, from all the other organizations we contacted in that they will stay with us and help implement any plan. Believe me, we interviewed some of the best in the way of planning consultants and this is unique. It's another reason why it's money well spent.

Deadman doesn't see parking as a crucial factor although some others do.

There are 800 parking spaces in the downtown area, the city manager said. "They are scattered," he added, "but they are there and people who shop the downtown area know where they are."

Woody claimed he would like to see an office building and "maybe a nice motel" along the block which might "attract some high fashion stores." But he saw parking as a problem.
