made through the Volunteer Bureau. **OLD GRACE HOSPITAL MEDICAL CENTER** (New Detroit Medical Center) in Detroit needs volunteers to work in the surgical lounge answering telephones, keeping the medical books, etc. Volunteers are also needed to work in the gift shop. Both areas are open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., but

hours are flexible. Volunteers are needed to assist with arts and crafts programs, reading, writing and visiting with bedridden residents. Orientation is provided to familiarize volunteers with hospital procedures. The Pontiac Jaycees are currently organizing an auxiliary of individual volunteers and community service groups who are interested in the Beverly Manor Convalescent Center. 
