

Farmington man leads national ADA in fighting for liberalism

Sipher, a resident of Farmington Hills, is the owner of a telephone answering service, Al-Mar, in Southfield.
Long an activist in politics and liberal causes, he became the ADA chairman in January.
Americans for Democratic Action is a non-partisan liberal organization which supports most liberal issues, he said.
"ADA had a role in the anti-Vietnam War movement and was a leader in the telephone drive against Richard Nixon," Sipher said.
He said that ADA's position on such problems has always been for the purpose of generally "lifting most or all of the people."
Sipher has been active in ADA and on its board of directors since it was reorganized in Michigan in 1968. He also was involved in several political campaigns including that of the late Robert Kennedy, in which he was an organizer for the City of Livonia.
As ADA chairman, Sipher is currently busy planning the upcoming ADA dinner scheduled for Saturday, Sept. 20 in the Raleigh House.

"WE'RE HOPING for 350-400 people there since a presidential campaign data, Congressman Morris K. Udall, will be the speaker. This will be his first time speaking in Michigan during this campaign."
"Alma, the Jeanne Schamel Memorial Award for outstanding community service will be awarded to past ADA chairman, Annette Miller, who has friends and admirers all over the state."
Mrs. Miller, a member of the State Board of Education, was a congressional candidate in 1970 on an anti-war platform. Although she lost her bid for Congress, she was nominated by the Michigan Democrats for the spot on the education board.
Before the ADA dinner, Sipher will attend a Democratic conference in Minneapolis Sept. 13-14.
