Even though your furnace has been kicking on and off since the cold weather began, it doesn't necessarily mean that all is well down there in your basement.
Safe and efficient furnaces require upkeep. If you haven't had a heating company check your furnace, you can go over it yourself.
Get a flashlight and a can of oil. First replace the filters if there's a layer of dirt on them. If you don't have replacements on hand, record the number on the cardboard frame. (b) the motor cups front and back and check the fan belt for fraying and cracks. Grease fittings and bearings.
Your humidifier should be cleaned at least once a year. Scrub out the deposits of lime inside—vinegar may help—and change the evaporator pads. Depending on the condition of your water, they should be changed every six weeks.

If it breaks down at night, you'll be charged for time and a half or double time on holidays. It might cost only \$25 or \$30 to save yourself a \$100 bill."
